When you open Zoom on your mobile device this is what it looks like.

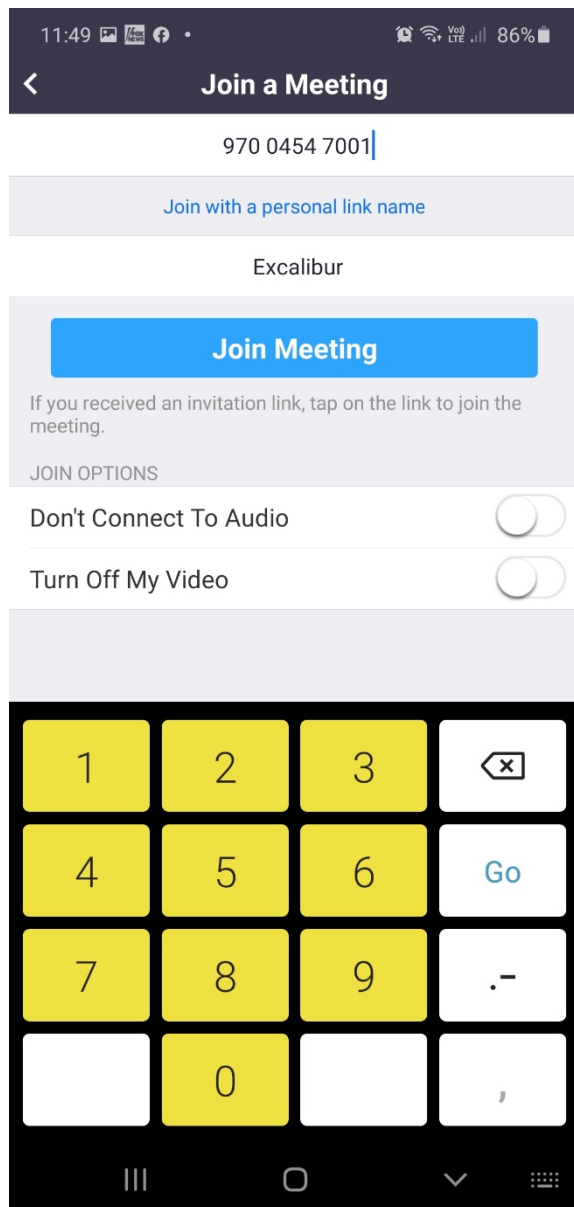
The mistake many people are making is to click **“Join a Meeting”** at this point. If you do then the following slides will explain what happens and what a lot of people are sending us.

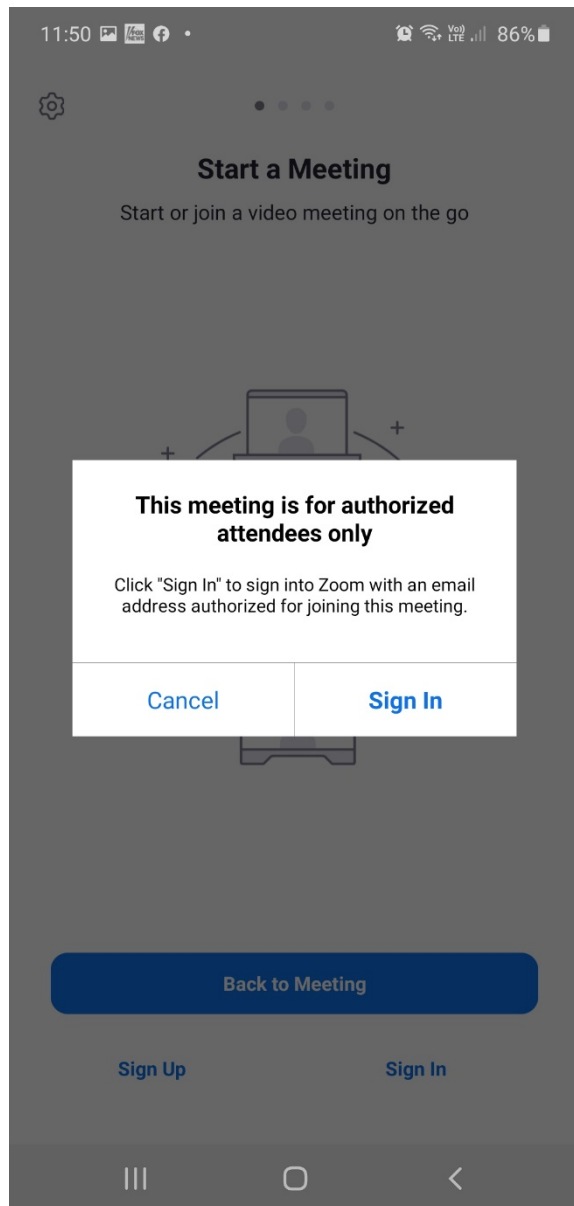

You then enter the **“Meeting ID”** and click **“Join Meeting”**

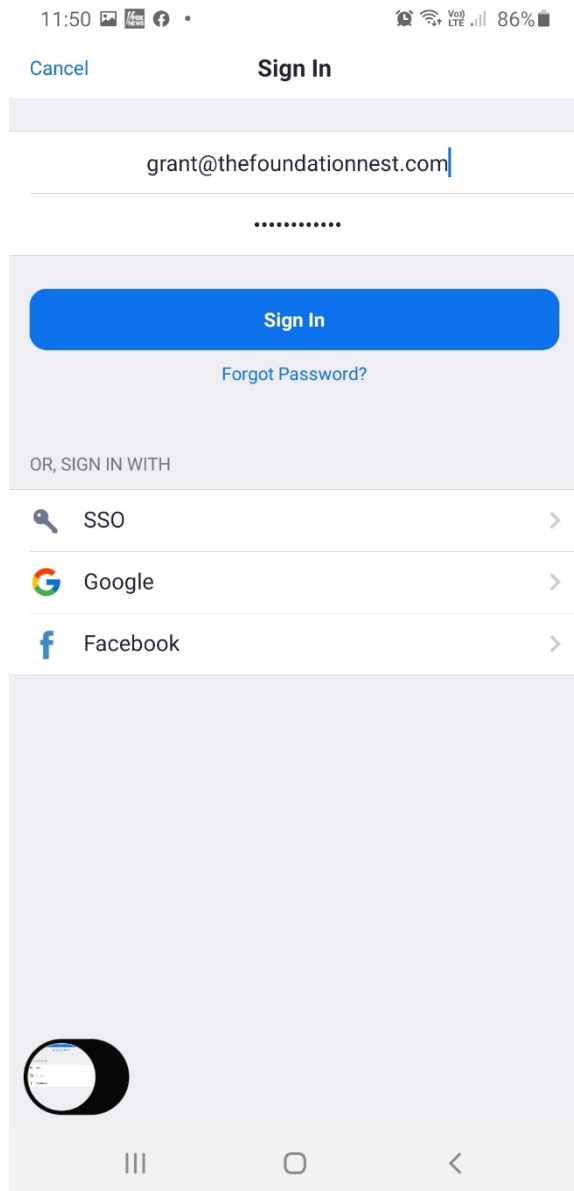
The following will happen...



You will get the following message

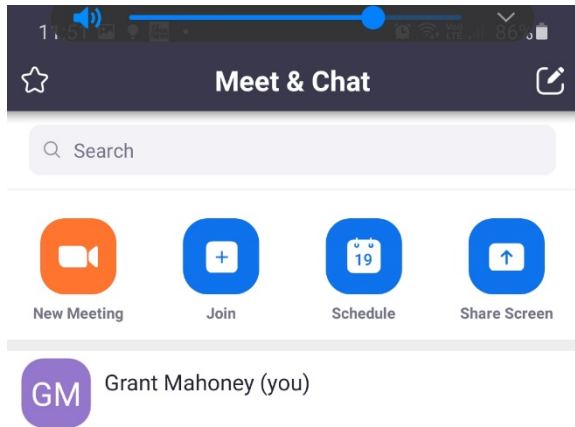
**“This meeting is for authorized attendees only”**

The reason this happens is because you did not sign into your Zoom account, which is free to register for.



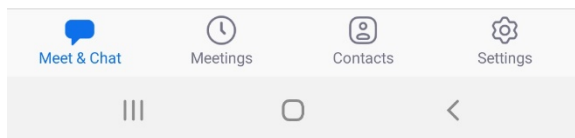
What you need to do is click **“Sign In”** and sign into your Zoom account.

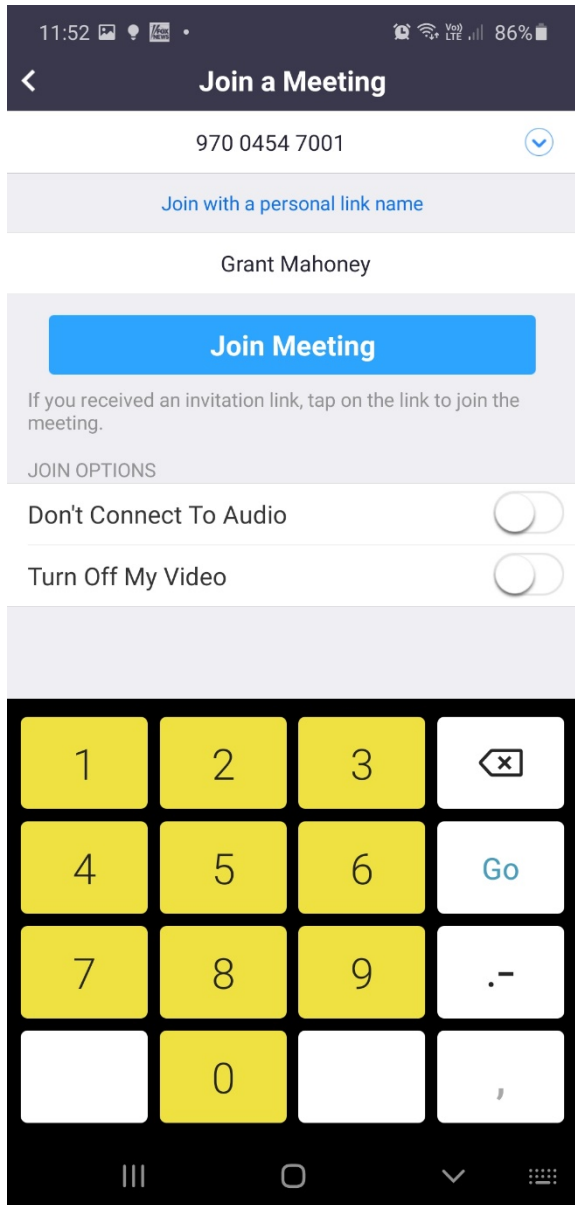
Enter you email and password in the provided fields and click **“Sign In”**



Once you are logged into your Zoom account, this is the screen you will be presented with.

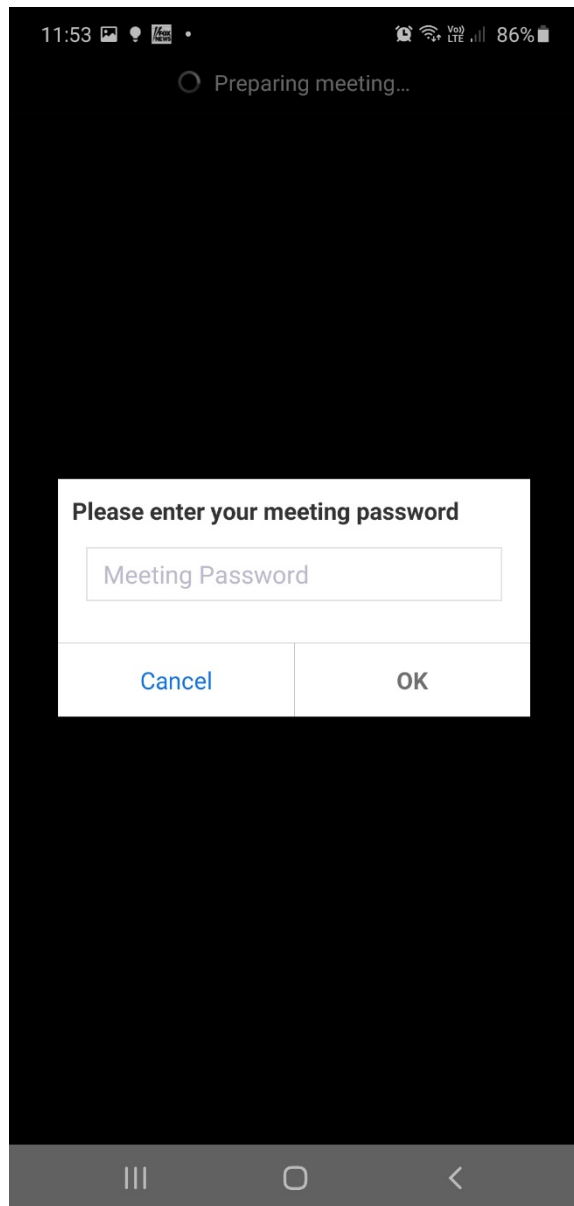
Now click the **“Join”** button.
